

FRAUSCHER 909 BENACO

A striking day cruiser

Frauscher's new born is an innovative day cruiser called Benaco 909 that is truly striking for its old and ultra modern styling mix. The Benaco model is at top of the Austrian shipyard's range and deliberately designed to attract even those wishing to go on a small cruise down the coast, perhaps. In actual fact the Benaco 909 is the first, of the Frauschers, to have an internal cabin, albeit small but capable of hosting two people overnight. The exterior layout has the usual choice of ergonomic seats for the pilot and co-driver, a smart coffee table, a stern sofa with stowage room underneath and a large sunbathing area, behind it, that covers the engines too. The deck-laid flooring is a fine

example of what a modern "runabout" should be like with its: central engine position freeing lateral passageway to reach the stern platform, well padded styled seating, ergonomic steering wheel derived from the automotive industry, well placed stainless steel grabhandles that are well encased into the top of the sides and thanks, to her two 235 HP engines, the 909 Benaco is credited with having reached a top speed of 40 knots.
